BY-LAW No. 331-2007

To designate the Scarborough Centre as a Community Improvement Project Area.

WHEREAS subsection 28(2) of the *Planning Act* provides that the Council of a municipality which has an official plan containing provisions relating to community improvement, may by by-law designate the whole or any part of an area covered by such an official plan as a community improvement project area; and

WHEREAS the City of Toronto Official Plan contains provisions relating to community improvement in the area contemplated by this by-law; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has determined it appropriate to authorize designation of certain land hereinafter described as a community improvement project area;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The area outlined by heavy lines on Attachment "1", attached to and forming part of this by-law, is designated as a community improvement project area within the meaning of Section 28 of the *Planning Act*.
- 2. The community improvement project area shown on Attachment "1" shall be known as the Scarborough Centre Community Improvement Project Area.
