**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 344-2007**

**To permanently close the public lane lying east of Yonge Street and south of Byng Avenue.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane lying east of Yonge Street and south of Byng Avenue be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause 69 of North York Community Council Report 7, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on September 25, 26 and 27, 2006; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the North York Community Council at its meeting held on March 27, 2007;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane lying east of Yonge Street and south of Byng Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:

Lane on Plan 2282, Township of York, lying south of Byng Avenue, City of Toronto  
(former City of North York)
