CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 370-2007

To provide for the temporary sidewalk and curb lane closure on the north side of Richmond Street East, west of Sherbourne Street, and the temporary closure of the east half of Stonecutters Lane near Richmond Street East.

WHEREAS the City may, pursuant to sections 6, 7 and 8 of the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006, pass by-laws respecting, amongst other things, matters related to highways; and

WHEREAS pursuant to section 39 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* the City, has except as otherwise provided in the Act, the ability to pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In order to facilitate construction of a 6-storey building at 294 Richmond Street East, on the north-east corner of Richmond Street East and Sherbourne Street, the sidewalk and curb lane on the north side of Richmond Street East between a point 4 metres west of Sherbourne Street and a point 86 metres west of Sherbourne Street, is temporarily closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic and the east half of Stonecutters Lane between Richmond Street East and a point 10 metres north of Richmond Street East, is closed to pedestrian and vehicular traffic, for a period commencing April 12, 2007 and terminating on January 25, 2008.
