BY-LAW No. 372-2007

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86 designating certain locations on former
Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Islington Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law “To designate certain locations on Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers”, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Islington Avenue (M.T. 63)	between east side (northbound Islington Avenue) and centre pedestrian refuge island immediately south of Golfdown Drive
