BY-LAW No. 430-2007

To provide for the narrowing of the roadway on Lansdowne Avenue, between College Street and Bloor Street West.

WHEREAS the City may, pursuant to sections 6, 7 and 8 of the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006, pass by-laws respecting, amongst other things, matters related to highways; and

WHEREAS pursuant to section 39 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* the City, has except as otherwise provided in the Act, the ability to pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In order to facilitate the reconstruction of Lansdowne Avenue, the travelled portion of Lansdowne Avenue between College Street and Bloor Street West shall be narrowed as shown in Drawing Nos. 421F-8467, 421F-8468, 421F-8469 and 421F-8470 (dated March 2007) attached to this by-law.




