BY-LAW No. 444-2007

To rename part of Bathurst Street south of Queens Quay West as “Eireann Quay”.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto had before it a motion to rename part of Bathurst Street south of Queens Quay West as “Eireann Quay” to commemorate the role of the Irish in the development of the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS the motion requested the Council of the City of Toronto to grant an exception to the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land comprised of part of the public street known as Bathurst Street, located south of Queens Quay West, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21418-0107 (LT)

Part of Bathurst Street on Plan D-1442 designated as PART 1 on Plan Number 2007-0076.

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

is renamed “Eireann Quay”.
