**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 445-2007**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,  
respecting Bastedo Avenue, Hanson Street, Howie Avenue and Ossington Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- A. By inserting in Schedule IV (Stop Intersections) in § 400-57, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Bastedo Avenue and Hanson Street	Bastedo Avenue
Hanson Street and Bastedo Avenue	Hanson Street
Howie Avenue and Clark Street	Howie Avenue (southbound)

- B. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Ossington Avenue	East	Dundas Street West and Hallam Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

- C. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Ossington Avenue	East	Dundas Street West and Harrison Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Mon. to Fri., except public holidays
Ossington Avenue	East	A point 70 metres north of Harrison Street and Hallam Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

D. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in § 400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Ossington Avenue	East	Harrison Street and a point 70 metres north	7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.
