BY-LAW No. 449-2007

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt a portion of a swimming pool enclosure on the property municipally known as 68 Frost Street from certain construction standards.

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A to Chapter 447, Fences, is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing chain link fence consisting of metal mesh 50 millimetres in size, interwoven with vinyl slats, and forming part of a swimming pool enclosure at the property known as 68 Frost Street, may be retained despite the requirement in § 447-3E(2)(a) that chain link mesh used in swimming pool enclosures be a maximum of 38 millimetres in size, and the opening window which forms part of the swimming pool enclosure may be maintained although it does not have a limiting device to prevent it opening more than 100 millimetres, as required in § 447-3C(3).
