BY-LAW No. 490-2007

**To enact an Interim Control By-law for lands within the O'Connor/Bermondsey
Employment District.**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has, by adopting Notice of Motion M58 at its meeting of May 23, 24 and 25, 2007, directed that a review be undertaken in respect of the appropriate land uses permitted in the O'Connor/Bermondsey Employment District; and

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass an Interim Control By-law for a period of time which shall not exceed one year from the date of passage of the By-law for such purposes as are set out in the By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Places of worship are prohibited on any of the lands shown within the heavy lines on Map 1 and Map 2 attached to this by-law.
2. This by-law shall not apply to:
 - (i) any places of worship which legally existed on any lands shown within the heavy lines on Map 1 and Map 2 attached to this by-law on the day of enactment of this by-law; and
 - (ii) the property known municipally as Unit 10, 45 Cranfield Road, more particularly described as Unit 10, Metropolitan Toronto Condominium Plan 1419, City of Toronto.
3. This By-law expires one year from the date of its enactment by Council.
