CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 538-2007

To authorize the alteration of Queen's Park, south of Bloor Street West for the purposes of extending the bus lay-by fronting the Royal Ontario Museum.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The following alterations are authorized:
 - (i) the widening of the pavement on the west side of Queen's Park, from a point 38 metres south of Bloor Street West to a point 15 metres north thereof, by extending the existing lay-by, generally as shown in the print of Drawing No. 421F-8782 dated April, 2007, attached to this by-law as Attachment 1 and on file in the offices of Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.
