BY-LAW No. 593-2007

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Lake Shore Boulevard West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law "To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads", is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Lake Shore Boulevard West, eastbound, between 60 kilometres per hour
Mimico Creek and the Humber River

Lake Shore Boulevard West, westbound, between 60 kilometres per hour
Mimico Creek and the Toronto Transit Commission
streetcar underpass located north of the F.G. Gardiner
Expressway at a point approximately 450 metres west
of the Humber River

Lake Shore Boulevard West, westbound, between the 70 kilometres per hour
Humber River and the Toronto Transit Commission
streetcar underpass located north of the F.G. Gardiner
Expressway at a point approximately 450 metres west
of the Humber River and the Humber River

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Lake Shore Boulevard West, eastbound, south of the 60 kilometres per hour
F.G. Gardiner Expressway, between Palace Pier Court
and the Humber River

Lake Shore Boulevard West, westbound, north of the 60 kilometres per hour
F.G. Gardiner Expressway, between Toronto Transit
Commission streetcar underpass located north of the
F.G. Gardiner Expressway at a point approximately
450 metres west of the Humber River and Lake Shore
Boulevard West

Lake Shore Boulevard West, westbound, north of the
F.G. Gardiner Expressway, between the Humber River
and the Toronto Transit Commission streetcar
underpass located north of the F.G. Gardiner
