BY-LAW No. 635-2007

**To delegate authority to establish business improvement area boards of management to
Community Councils.**

WHEREAS subsection 21(1) of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* (the “Act”) provides that the City may delegate its legislative and quasi-judicial powers under the Act to a council committee; and

WHEREAS City Council wishes to delegate to the community councils the authority to establish business improvement area boards of management after a business improvement area has been designated, except where the business improvement area is located in the geographic area of more than one community council; and

WHEREAS Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, must be amended to give effect to the delegation to the community councils; and

WHEREAS public notice was given of the intention to amend the procedures by-law prior to Council’s adoption of the amendments to Chapter 27, Council Procedures to delegate to community councils the power to establish business improvement area boards of management;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following to § 27-152E:
 - (6) Establishment of business improvement area boards of management after Council enacts a by-law to designate the business improvement area.
