BY-LAW No. 664-2007

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 591, Noise, to reflect the prohibition of railway whistles at the pedestrian crossing near Corvette Avenue at Mileage 59.96 of the Uxbridge Subdivision under the *Railway Safety Act*.

WHEREAS under section 23.1 of the *Railway Safety Act*, R.S.C. 1985 (4th Supp.), the use of whistles on railway equipment is prohibited in certain areas if certain conditions are met including the condition that the government of the municipality by resolution declares that it agrees that such whistles should not be used in that area;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 591, Noise, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting row D. and replacing it with the following in the table in § 591-13:
