## BY-LAW No. 665-2007

## To make a technical amendment to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes.

Whereas it is necessary to make a technical amendment to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Section 886-10B of the Municipal Code is deleted and replaced with the following:
  - "B. Despite § 886-10A, no person operating a vehicle in a bicycle lane for the purposes set out in § 886-10A shall operate a vehicle in the lane for a distance exceeding forty-five (45) metres."
