**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 672-2007**

**To dedicate certain land on the east side of Morrish Road, north of Old Kingston Road, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Morrish Road.**

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with a Site Plan Approval Application No. 05 105857 ESC 44 SA and a Transfer/Deed of Land registered as Instrument No. AT1233013 respecting 271 Morrish Road;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:
