BY-LAW No. 762-2007

To provide for the temporary closure and sidewalk diversion on Fredrick Street.

WHEREAS City of Toronto Council has delegated the legislative authority for local routine matters, such as the temporary closing of streets, to Community Councils by adopting Executive Committee Item 2.5, as amended, at its meeting held on February 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007; and

WHEREAS pursuant to § 27-152B(6) of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law temporarily closing roads; and

WHEREAS the City may, pursuant to sections 6, 7 and 8 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, pass by-laws respecting, amongst other things, matters related to highways; and

WHEREAS pursuant to section 39 of the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006 the City, has except as otherwise provided in the Act, the ability to pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In order to facilitate the restoration of a 4 storey building at 215 King Street East, the curb lane on the west side of Fredrick Street is temporarily closed and the sidewalk on the west side of Fredrick Street is temporarily diverted, between King Street and a point 35 metres further south, from July 1, 2007, to November 1, 2007.
