CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 775-2007

To provide for the temporary closure of part of Jarvis Street.

WHEREAS the City may, pursuant to sections 6, 7 and 8 of the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006, pass by-laws respecting, amongst other things, matters related to highways; and

WHEREAS pursuant to section 39 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* the City, has except as otherwise provided in the Act, the ability to pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In order to facilitate construction of a 44 storey condominium at 590 Jarvis Street, the sidewalk and curb lane on the west side of Jarvis Street between a point 13.5 metres north of Charles Street East and a point 50.5 metres north of Charles Street East, are temporarily closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic from July 18, 2007 to July 18, 2010.
