**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 777-2007**

**To provide for the temporary closure of part of Adelaide Street East.**

WHEREAS the City may, pursuant to sections 6, 7 and 8 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, pass by-laws respecting, amongst other things, matters related to highways; and

WHEREAS pursuant to section 39 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* the City, has except as otherwise provided in the Act, the ability to pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In order to facilitate construction of a 14 storey rental building at 501 Adelaide Street East, the sidewalk and curb lane on the south side of Adelaide Street East between a point 50.4 metres east of Ontario Street and a point 95.2 metres east of Ontario Street, are temporarily closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic from July 18, 2007 to December 31, 2008.
