BY-LAW No. 781-2007

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 195, Purchasing, to reflect the reorganization of the City's administrative structure.

WHEREAS by the adoption of Policy and Finance Committee Report 5, Clause 1 at its meeting held on June 27, 28 and 29, 2006, Council adopted a new governance structure to commence with the new term of Council, including an Executive Committee and new Standing Committees; and

WHEREAS by the adoption of Executive Committee Item 4.10 at its meeting held on March 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007, Council renamed the "General Government" Committee to the "Government Management" Committee; and

WHEREAS by the adoption of Policy and Finance Committee Report 4, Clause 40 at its meeting held on April 12, 13 and 14, 2005, Council has authorized the City Solicitor to submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS Article I, Interpretation, of Chapter 1, General Provisions, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code applies to City by-laws;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Chapter 195, Purchasing, is amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 195-5J is amended by deleting "General Government Committee" and substituting "Government Management Committee".
 - (2) Section 195-9C is amended by deleting "General Government Committee" and substituting "Government Management Committee".
 - (3) Section 195-14A is amended by deleting "General Government Committee" and substituting "Government Management Committee".
 - (4) Section 195-17B is amended by deleting "General Government Committee" and substituting "Government Management Committee".
