CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 909-2007

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Oakmount Road and Windermere Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Oakmount Road	East	A point 127 metres north of Glenlake Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Windermere Avenue	East	A point 88.5 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Windermere Avenue	East	A point 132.7 metres north of Colbeck Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Windermere Avenue	West	A point 93 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
