BY-LAW No. 999-2007

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on
former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Lansdowne Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

Lansdowne Avenue and Bloor Street West	Bloor Street West and a point 30.5 metres north	Easterly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound left-turning
Lansdowne Avenue and College Street	College Street and a point 30.5 metres south	Westerly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound left-turning (T.T.C. vehicles excepted)
