BY-LAW No. 1002-2007

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, designating certain locations on former
Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Dundas Street West,
Kingston Road, Kipling Avenue and Weston Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law "To designate certain locations on Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers", as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Dundas Street West	Immediately west of Chestnut Hill Crescent
Kingston Road	Immediately east of Queensbury Avenue
Kipling Avenue (M.T. 3)	between east side (northbound Kipling Avenue) and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately 88 metres south of Henley Crescent
Kipling Avenue (M.T. 3)	between west side (southbound Kipling Avenue) and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately 88 metres south of Henley Crescent
Weston Road	Approximately 67 metres north of Habitant Drive
