CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1007-2007

To change the name of the public highway “Sufferance Road”, located north of Highway 401, extending easterly from Kennedy Road, to “Village Green Square”.

WHEREAS the City of Toronto’s Street Naming Policy states that the names of streets and lanes should not be changed unless there are duplicate street names or it would improve the City’s administration of essential services; and

WHEREAS the renaming of the public highway “Sufferance Road” to “Village Green Square” does not fall within the exception found within the City of Toronto’s Street Naming Policy; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has granted an exception to the Street Naming Policy to rename “Sufferance Road” to “Village Green Square”, so as to strengthen the neighbourhood community;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public highway “Sufferance Road” comprised of the land, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows:

PIN 06164-0196 (LT)

PARCEL 28-5 & 28-6, SECT S-6 SUFFERANCE ROAD PT LOT 28, CON 2
SCAR BEING PTS 1 & 2 R4800 & PTS 1 & 2 R5078

City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough)
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is renamed as “Village Green Square”.
