BY-LAW No. 1009-2007

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Eglinton Avenue West, Highway 400 Northbound Off-ramp at Finch Avenue West, Finch Avenue West and Steeles Avenue West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Pedestrian Crossings Prohibited) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Eglinton Avenue West

Between the east curb line of Oakwood Avenue and a point 30.5 metres east of the east curb line of Oakwood Avenue

Finch Avenue West and Highway 400

Northbound Off-ramp (west leg of signalized intersection)

Between the west curb line of the Highway 400

Northbound Off-ramp and a point 30.5 metres west

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:
