To permanently close a portion of the public lane abutting 286 King Street East and 501 Adelaide Street East.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public lane abutting 286 King Street East and 501 Adelaide Street East, shown as Part 1 on PS-2005-145, be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Toronto and East York Community Council Item 6.46, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on June 19, 20 and 22, 2007; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on September 10, 2007;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public lane abutting 286 King Street East and 501 Adelaide Street East, shown as Part 1 on PS-2005-145, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:

Part of PIN 21091-0225 (LT)

Part of the Block Unnamed on Plan D-126 dedicated for public lane purposes by City of Toronto By-law No. 545-90 (CA112799) and part of the Lane on Plan D-126 designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-22972, City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66).
