**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1048-2007**

**To permanently close a portion of the public highway Oakburn Place, branching southerly from the south side of Oakburn Crescent.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway Oakburn Place, branching southerly from the south side of Oakburn Crescent, be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Government Management Committee Item 6.12, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on July 16, 17, 18 and 19, 2007; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the North York Community Council at its meeting held on September 10, 2007;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. A portion of the public highway Oakburn Place, branching southerly from the south side of Oakburn Crescent, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 10104-0555 (LT)  
Part of Oakburn Place, Plan 4460 North York,  
Toronto (N York), City of Toronto,  
designated as Part 3 on Plan 66R-23232

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not take effect until the moment in time immediately prior to the registration in the appropriate land registry office of a Transfer, by the City of Toronto as transferor, of the lands described in Section 1 of this By-law.
