BY-LAW No. 1054-2007

**To establish an obligatory reserve fund named the North Rosedale Reserve Fund and
to amend Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, to add this
reserve fund.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The North Rosedale Reserve Fund is hereby established for the purpose of receiving cash donations toward enhancements of parks and publicly-owned and accessible ravines within the North Rosedale community and for operating Parks, Forestry and Recreation programs within the North Rosedale community.
2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, be amended by adding the following to Schedule No. 9 – Donations Reserve Fund:

“North Rosedale

Parks, Forestry and
Recreation

Receives cash donations

and Recreation programs

community”
