BY-LAW No. 1097-2007

To authorize highway alterations on Riverside Drive and Second Street.

WHEREAS City of Toronto Council has delegated the legislative authority for local routine matters, such as the alteration of streets, to Community Councils by adopting Executive Committee Item 2.5, as amended, at its meeting held on February 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007; and

WHEREAS pursuant to § 27-152B(5) of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Etobicoke York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law altering a road; and

WHEREAS the construction of these highway alterations will enhance pedestrian safety and improve traffic operations at various locations within the Etobicoke York District;

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The following alterations are authorized:
 - a. The narrowing of Second Street, south of Lake Shore Drive from 8.5 m wide to 6.0 m wide, generally as shown on the Drawing No. SK-3, dated June 6, 2007, attached as Attachment 1 and on file in the Traffic Operations, Etobicoke York District Office.
 - b. The extension of an island on Riverside Drive, south of Bloor Street West, from 7.5 m to 15 m, generally as shown on Drawing No. Y07641-001, dated July, 2007, attached as Attachment 2 and on file in the Traffic Operations, Etobicoke York District Office.

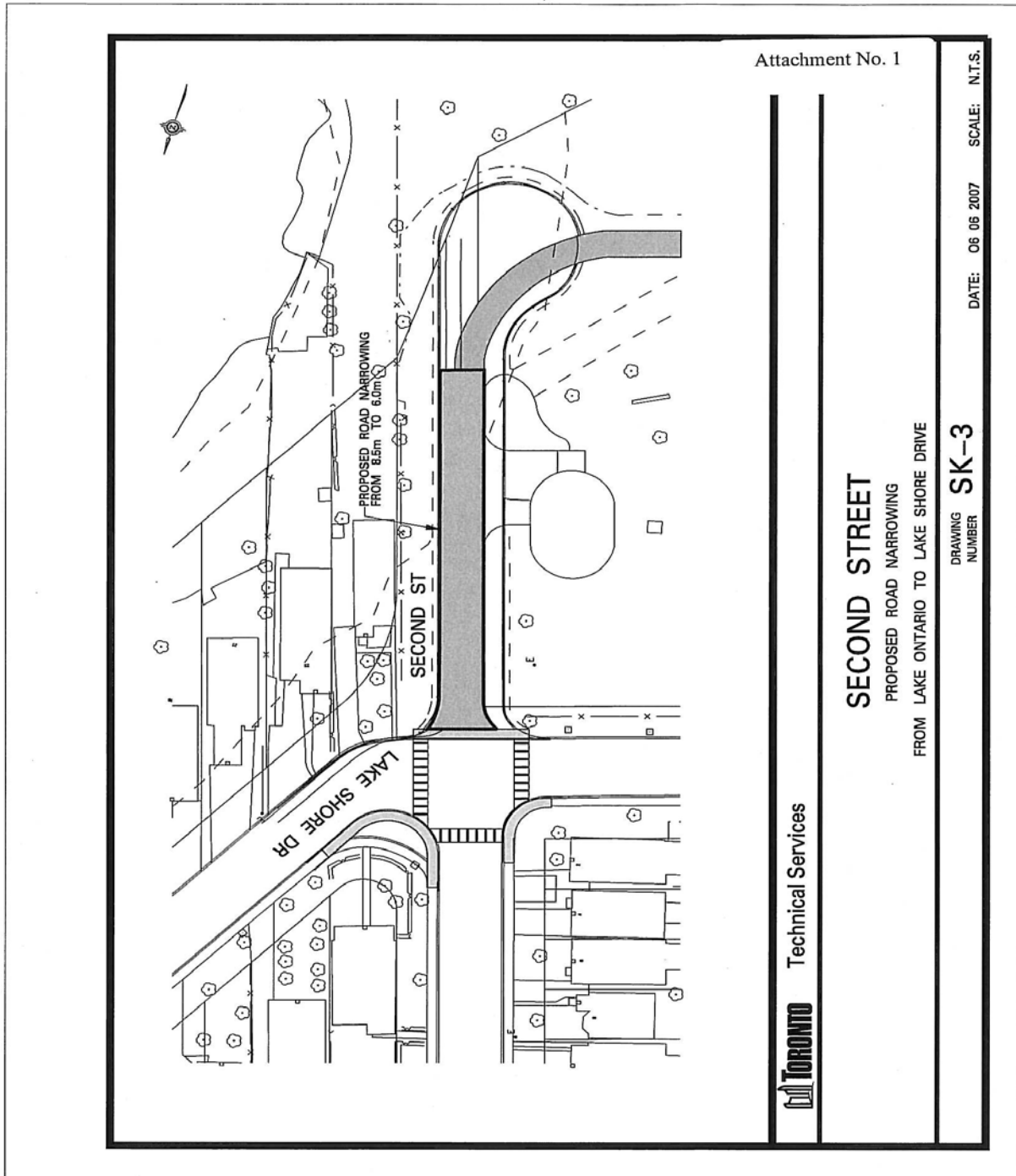
