BY-LAW No. 1154-2007

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Greenwood Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
- A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

Greenwood Avenue	West, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Torbrick Avenue and Danforth Avenue
Greenwood Avenue	West, adjacent to the curb	A point 80 metres north of Walpole Avenue and Torbrick Road
Greenwood Avenue	West, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	A point 25 metres north of Walpole Avenue and a point 80 metres north of Walpole Avenue
Greenwood Avenue	West, adjacent to the curb	Ivy Avenue and a point 25 metres north of Walpole Avenue
Greenwood Avenue	West, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Queen Street West and Ivy Avenue
