BY-LAW No. 1186-2007

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, respecting King Edward Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Kenrae Road and Randolph Road” and “Kings Park Boulevard and Dewhurst Boulevard” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 2
Stop Streets)

King Edward Avenue and Burrell Avenue

King Edward Avenue
(northbound and southbound)
