BY-LAW No. 1188-2007

To amend further By-law No. 34-93, a by-law “To provide for disabled person parking permit holders”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Cedarcrest Boulevard.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule ‘F’ (Designated On-Street Pick-up/Drop-off Spaces for the Disabled) of By-law No. 34-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Brenton Street” and “Coleridge Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Cedarcrest Boulevard	West	A point 81.5 metres south of Glencrest Boulevard and a point 11.5 metres further south	Anytime from Nov. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive
