**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1219-2007**

**To amend former Scarborough By-law No. 23949, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Roads in the City of Scarborough”, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.**

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, directed that the voluntary payment amounts for all parking offences be eliminated; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend former Scarborough By-law No. 23949, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Roads in the City of Scarborough” to reflect this recommendation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 23949 of the former City of Scarborough, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Roads in the City of Scarborough”, is amended by repealing subsection 50(c).
