CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1227-2007

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, to require commercial dog walker permits to be displayed when walking four to six dogs.

WHEREAS under sections 7 and 8 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* (the “Act”), the City may pass by-laws respecting the use of its parks system; and

WHEREAS Council has approved an amendment to Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, to require commercial dog walkers to display a commercial dog walker permit when walking four to six dogs;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 608-34.1B(1) of Chapter 608, Parks, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is deleted and the following substituted:

- (1) Display the commercial dog walker permit in a visible manner when walking four to six dogs;
