**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1252-2007**

**To amend the City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 681, Sewers.**

WHEREAS Council may pass by-laws with respect to any service or thing provided or done by or on behalf of the City and with respect to public assets and structures of the City, pursuant to section 8 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, including the right to regulate or prohibit with respect such matters;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 681, Sewers, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

By adding the following to § 681-11S. Storm water drainage:

- “(3) No person shall permit or maintain the connection of a downspout from any building directly or indirectly to a combined or storm sewer in the combined sewer area of the City, as identified on the map attached as Attachment 1.
- (4) The General Manager may exempt properties from § 681-11S(3) where the General Manager, in the General Manager’s sole discretion, determines that the disconnection of the downspouts, in respect to a property, would create a hazardous condition or is not technically feasible.”

2. This by-law comes into force three years from the date of its enactment.
