## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW No. 1265-2007

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting Greenwood Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, is amended as follows:
  - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Greenwood Avenue	Ivy Avenue and a point 25 metres north of Walpole Avenue	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Greenwood Avenue	A point 25 metres north of Walpole Avenue and a point 80 metres north of Walpole Avenue	Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used of parking	Anytime
