BY-LAW No. 1290-2007

To amend the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke with respect to Traffic - Chapter 240, Article I, regarding Earlington Avenue and Thorndale Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 240, Article I, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke is hereby amended by the deletion from the street or portions thereof and regulations under the headings set out herein and therein as follows:

- (a) deletions(s) to SCHEDULE XI – No Standing
