BY-LAW No. 1329-2007

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt the fence on the property municipally known as 16 Browside Avenue from the maximum height requirements.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A to Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing wood/lattice fence, measuring approximately 3.7 metres in height and 12.5 metres in length along the west side of the property; 3.4 metres in height and 4.8 metres in length along the north side of the property, and 3.4 metres in height and 4.8 metres in length along the south side of the property, forming part of a swimming pool enclosure and located in the rear yard of the property known as 16 Browside Avenue, may be retained despite the height restriction in § 447-2B of 2 metres for such fences, provided that the fence is removed when the owners cease to occupy the property, and the owners advise Municipal Licensing and Standards when they propose to vacate the property.
