BY-LAW No. 1410-2007

To amend Zoning By-law No. 779-2007, with respect to the lands municipally known as 3694-3700 Bathurst Street.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*; and

WHEREAS at its meeting of July 16, 17, 18 and 19, 2007 Council adopted By-law No. 779-2007 with respect to the lands municipally known as 3694-3700 Bathurst Street; and

WHEREAS a minor technical error with respect to landscaping requirements was detected only after the enacting of the By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** By-law No. 779-2007 is hereby amended by deleting the text at Section 2 (c) and replacing it with:
 - (c) Landscaping:

A minimum 1.2 metre landscaped strip shall be provided along the full length of a lot line that abuts any R or RM zone.

2. The remainder of By-law No. 779-2007 remains in full force and effect.
