BY-LAW No. 1309-2008

To amend By-law No. 32100 of the former City of North York, respecting vending on sidewalks and untravelled portions of roads of the City of North York, to expand the types of foods which may be sold from a portable display unit.

WHEREAS the Minister of Health and Long Term Care for Ontario announced on July 7, 2007 an amendment to Ontario Regulation 562 under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* to expand the types of food which may be sold by vendors from street food vending carts, subject to municipal regulation; and

WHEREAS Council has authorized a pilot project to permit the sale of additional types of healthier foods from locations on City property; and

WHEREAS the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* (the “*Act*”) provides that Council may pass by-laws in respect of the health, safety and well-being of persons and the economic, social and environmental well-being of the City;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 32100 of the former City of North York, “Respecting vending on sidewalks and untravelled portions of roads of the City of North York”, is amended by adding the following section:
 - 15B. Despite Section 15A, persons operating a portable vending unit under Municipal Code Chapter 738, Street Food, Healthier shall be permitted to vend additional food products as permitted under that chapter.
