CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1315-2008

To amend the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code Chapter 231, Streets and Sidewalks, to expand the types of foodstuffs which may be sold from a street food vending cart.

WHEREAS the Minister of Health and Long Term Care for Ontario announced on July 7, 2007 an amendment to Ontario Regulation 562 under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* to expand the types of food which may be sold by vendors from street food vending carts, subject to municipal regulation; and

WHEREAS Council has authorized a pilot project to permit the sale of additional types of healthier foods from locations on City property; and

WHEREAS the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006 (the "Act") provides that Council may pass by-laws in respect of the health, safety and well-being of persons and the economic, social and environmental well-being of the City;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 231, Streets and Sidewalks, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke is amended by adding the following section:

§ 231-23.2. Permitting healthier foodstuffs.

Despite § 231-23.1, persons operating a street food vending cart under Municipal Code Chapter 738, Street Food, Healthier shall be permitted to place, expose for sale or sell by retail additional foodstuffs as permitted under that chapter.
