### BY-LAW No. 36-2009

#### **To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Catalina Drive, Prince Philip Boulevard, Bournville Drive and Rowatson Road.**

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XVIII (Through Streets) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:
