**BY-LAW No. 40-2009**

**To authorize the alteration of Dixon Avenue, between Kingston Road and Lockwood Road, by the installation of a speed hump.**

WHEREAS a traffic calming poll of households on Dixon Avenue, between Kingston Road and Woodbine Avenue, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of a speed hump on Dixon Avenue, between Kingston Road and Lockwood Road, specifically fronting premises No. 24 Dixon Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of a speed hump on Dixon Avenue, between Kingston Road and Lockwood Road, specifically fronting premises No. 24 Dixon Avenue, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-9400 dated August, 2008, on file in the offices of Transportation Services.
