BY-LAW No. 41-2009

To authorize the alteration of Knox Avenue, between Queen Street East and Eastern Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

WHEREAS a traffic calming poll of households on Knox Avenue, between Queen Street East and Eastern Avenue, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Knox Avenue, between Queen Street East and Eastern Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of speed humps on Knox Avenue, between Queen Street East and Eastern Avenue, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-9265 dated April, 2008, on file in the offices of Transportation Services.
