BY-LAW No. 88-2009

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, to include charges to request a hearing before the Commercial Dog Walker Permit Appeal Committee under City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks.

WHEREAS under the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the City may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and

WHEREAS the holding of a hearing by the Commercial Dog Walker Permit Appeal Committee for permit holders who wish to appeal the suspension of their commercial dog walker permit, is a service or activity provided by the City; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges to include the fees to request a hearing before the Commercial Dog Walker Permit Appeal Committee;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Appendix C, All Other Fees, Schedule 8, Parks & Recreation, of Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, is amended by adding the following after line 905:
