BY-LAW No. 127-2009

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 109-86, respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law "To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain Metropolitan Roads", is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, between 100 kilometres per hour Highway No. 427 and a point approximately 1000 metres west of the Kipling Avenue Underpass

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, between a 80 kilometres per hour point approximately 1000 metres west of the Kipling Avenue Underpass and a point approximately 100 metres east of the Kipling Avenue Underpass

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, between a 100 kilometres per hour point approximately 100 metres east of the Kipling Avenue Underpass and the Humber River

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), westbound, between 100 kilometres per hour Highway No. 427 and a point approximately 700 metres west of the Kipling Avenue Underpass

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), westbound, between 80 kilometres per hour a point approximately 700 metres west of the Kipling Avenue Underpass and a point approximately 400 metres east of the Kipling Avenue Underpass

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), westbound, between 100 kilometres per hour a point approximately 400 metres east of the Kipling Avenue Underpass and the Humber River

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, between 100 kilometres per hour Highway No. 427 and the Humber River

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), westbound, between 100 kilometres per hour Highway No. 427 and the Humber River
