**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 341-2009**

**To amend further By-law No. 34-93, a by-law “To provide for disabled person parking permit holders”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, respecting Milverton Boulevard and Sammon Avenue.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule ‘E’ (Designated On-Street Parking for the Disabled) of By-law No. 34-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Sammon Avenue	North	A point 19.0 metres east of Kimbourne Avenue and a point 24.5 metres east of Kimbourne Avenue	Anytime

2. Schedule 'E' (Designated On-Street Parking for the Disabled) of By-law No. 34-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words "Milverton Boulevard" and "Sibley Avenue" where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Milverton Boulevard	South	A point 82 metres west of Woodington Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
