## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 443-2009**

**To name the public lane south of Dundas Street East extending westerly from Seaton Street, then southerly to the lane first north of Shuter Street, thence easterly to Seaton Street as “Windeyer Lane”.**

WHEREAS City of Toronto Council has delegated the legislative authority for local routine matters, such as the naming of public lanes, to Community Councils by adopting Executive Committee Item 2.5, as amended, at its meeting held on February 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007; and

WHEREAS pursuant to § 27-152E(5) of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land comprised of the public lane located south of Dundas Street East extending westerly from Seaton Street, then southerly to the lane first north of Shuter Street, thence easterly to Seaton Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21090-0056 (LT)

Part of the lane on Plan 239 abutting the northerly limit of Lot 13 and the westerly limits of Lots 1 to 13 on the west side of Seaton Street all on Plan 239

Parts of Lots 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 41 designated as PARTS 1, 2, 3 and 4 on Plan CT727312

Part of Lot 4 on Plan 41 as in EP138710

PT 1 FOOT RESERVE PL 239 TORONTO; PT LT 11 PL 4A TORONTO;

PT LT 5 S/S BEECH ST, 6 S/S BEECH ST PL 239 TORONTO PT 2 63R3672

PT LT 13 PL 239 TORONTO AS IN EP106398;

Being the public lane south of Dundas Street East extending westerly from Seaton Street, then southerly to the lane first north of Shuter Street, thence easterly to Seaton Street

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario  
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is named as “Windeyer Lane”.
