**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 516-2009**

**To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a By-law  
“To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”, regarding Durie Street.**

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule VIII (No Parking) of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Durie Street	East	A point 97 metres south of St. Johns Road and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
