**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 735-2009**

**To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Lake Shore Boulevard West.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words and figures:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard (M.T. 2)	South	Humber River and a point 54 metres east of Freeland Street	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Lake Shore Boulevard West (Eastbound)	South	Humber River and Stadium Road	Anytime
Lake Shore Boulevard West (Eastbound)	South	A point 75 metres east of Stadium Road and a point 54 metres east of Freeland Street	Anytime

2. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Lake Shore Boulevard West (Eastbound)	South	Stadium Road and a point 75 metres east	Anytime
