CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 744-2009

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 415, Development of Land, to delegate authority to enter into Municipal Infrastructure Agreements.

WHEREAS section 20 (1) of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, authorizes the City to delegate its powers and duties under that or any other Act to a person or body;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by removing § 415-20 from Chapter 415 in its entirety and replacing it with the following section:

“§ 415-20. Authority to enter into municipal infrastructure agreements.

The authority to enter into municipal infrastructure agreements with developers to secure the construction of municipal infrastructure required to support developments or redevelopments that are the subject of a Site Plan Application is delegated to the Executive Director of Technical Services and his or her designates.”

2. The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following section:

“§ 415-21. Conflicting provisions.

To the extent of any conflict between this article and any by-law of a former municipality, this article shall prevail.”
